

## 1. RSYS PRIZES AND TROPHIES

### 1.1 Point scores

**1.1.1** For divisions with 7 or more entries, trophies or prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in the MAIN, SPR and SUM series' point scores based on PHS results for the inshore and offshore mixed divisions. For divisions with 5 or 6 entries 1st place only will be awarded in these point scores. Additional prizes will be awarded to the first three RSYS boats in each division of the CCIS point scores

**1.1.2** For the Etchells class, trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in the Club Championship series point scores based on scratch results, provided there are 7 or more entries. In the event of 5 or 6 entries, 1st place only will be awarded. The Phil Pearce Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the handicap series point score in the Club Championship.

### 1.2 Mini Regattas Point Scores

For divisions with 7 or more entries, trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd for scratch and 1st on handicap for each class in the overall Mini Regatta series. For divisions with 5 or 6 entries 1st place only will be awarded in the above point scores.

### 1.3 Twilight Series

**THU** - A prize will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each race, provided there are 7 or more entries. In divisions with six or less entries, 1st place only will be awarded.

**FRI** – A prize will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each race, provided there are 7 or more entries. In divisions with six or less entries, 1st place only will be awarded. A prize will be awarded for the overall series winner drawn from eligible boats.

**TUE** – A prize will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each race. In addition, the following trophies will be awarded:

- [Lady Helm Trophy](#) to the winner of the Ladies Combined One Design Division series.
- [Gypsy Moth IV Trophy](#) to the winner of the Non-spinnaker Ladies Division Trophy series.
- [Bluebird Trophy](#) to the winner of the Ladies Combined One Design Division Trophy series.
- [Inspiration Award](#) to a female sailor who has a love of sailing, commitment, enthusiasm and a growing skill base.

**SUN** – A prize will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each race in the Open Division and the Combined One Design Division provided there are seven or more entries. In divisions with six or less entries, 1st place only will be awarded. A prize will be awarded to the overall series winner in each division.

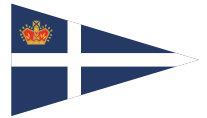
### 1.4 Individual Races

## 4 THE ROYAL PRINCE EDWARD YACHT CLUB PERPETUAL TROPHIES

*George Ryrie Memorial Trophy* - Winner of the No. 3 Division RPEYC season point score.

*William E Easy Memorial Trophy* - Winner of the International Etchells Class RPEYC season point score.

*Shore Cup* - Winner of the International Yngling Class RPEYC season point score.

*Horace J Muston Memorial Cup* - Winner of the International Yngling Class Mini Regatta Scratch RPEYC point score.

*Alastair George Memorial Trophy* - Winner of the Super Division Wednesday RPEYC point score series.

*Vincenza Trophy* - Winner of the A Division Wednesday RPEYC point score series.

*Christina II Trophy* - Winner of the B Division Wednesday RPEYC point score series.

*Cynara IV Trophy* - Winner of the C Division Wednesday RPEYC point score series.

Point score - 1st, five points; 2nd, three points; 3rd, two points where there are 8 or more block entries, except that where less than 8 boats enter - 1st, three points; 2nd, two points; 3rd, one point.
