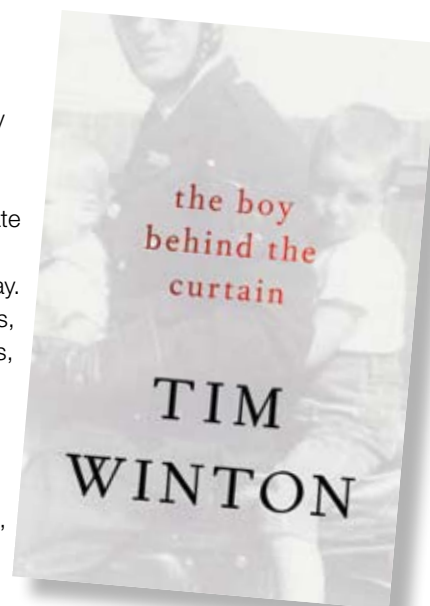

Please note, table bookings of 10 or more only can be taken, smaller bookings will be accommodated on large Club tables.

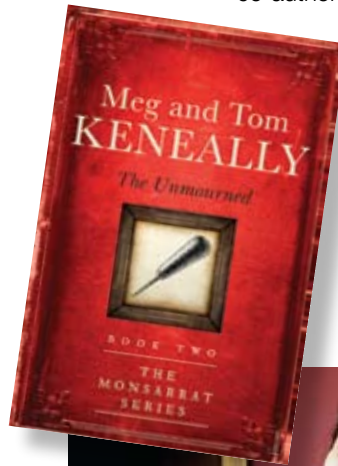


## Literary Luncheon

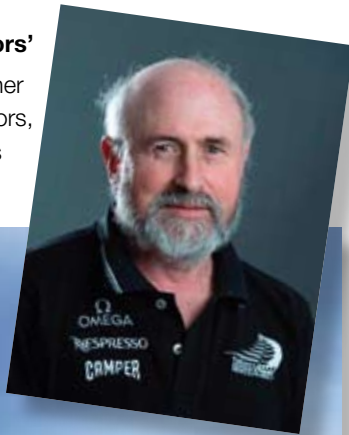
