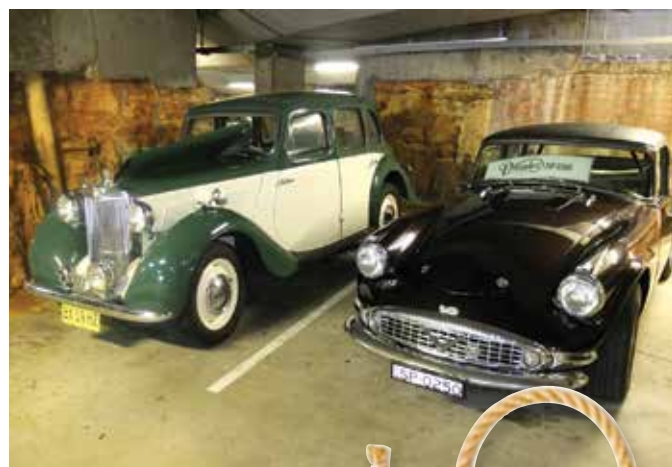
We will discuss 'The Dry' by Jane Harper, "A wonderful crime novel that shines a light into the darkest corner of a sunburnt country."

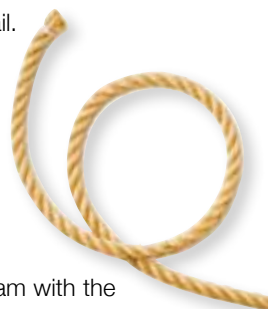
